Christ the King Crown

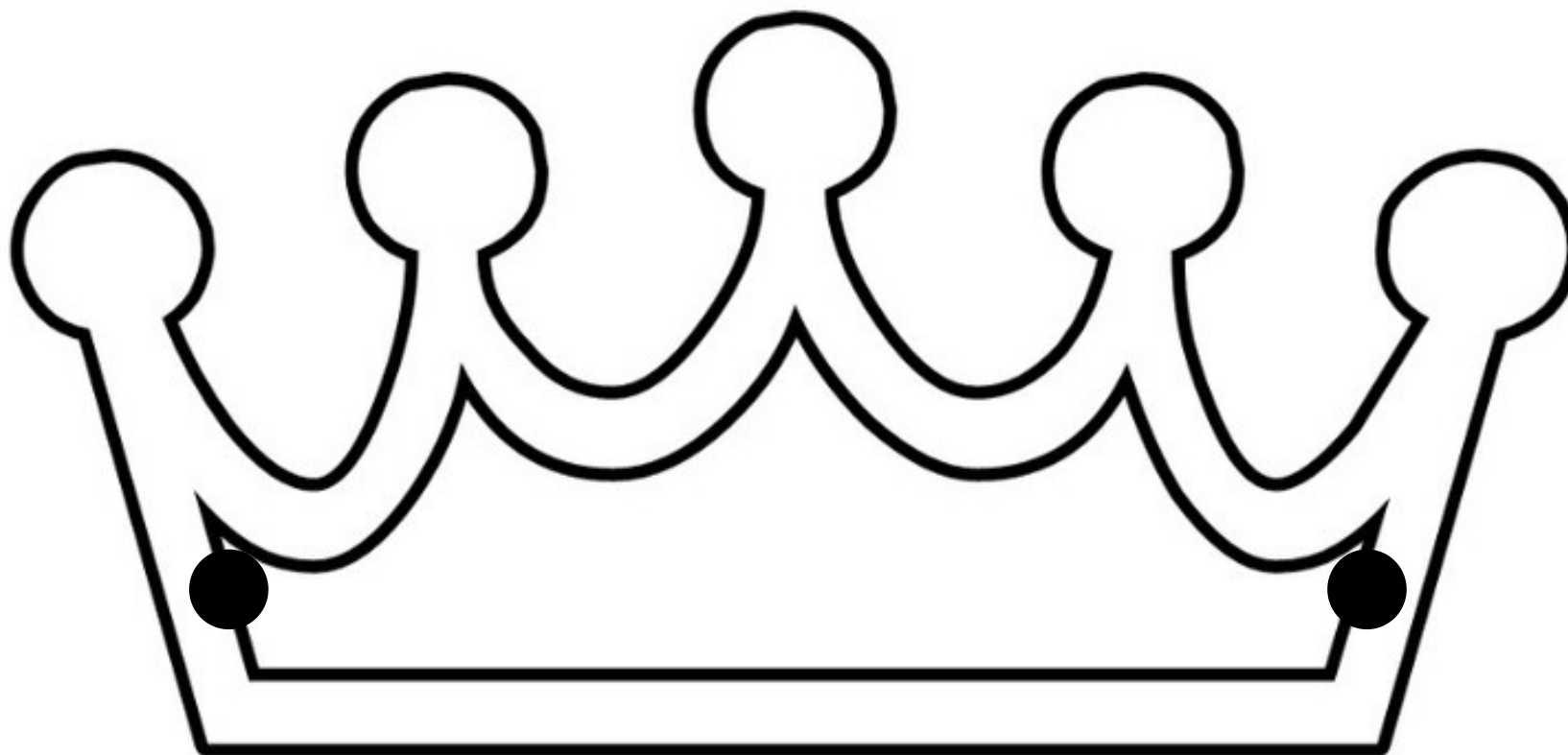
Christ the King Sunday is the last Sunday of our Church year. The Church year revolves around the life of Jesus Christ. So this week we remember that Jesus is the King of all creation. But what kind of king is he? Well, for one thing, he didn't live in a palace. He didn't wear a beautiful robe or a jewelled crown. He had no servants to wait on him and no soldiers to fight his battles. He didn't even have a country over which to rule and there were no coins engraved with his face or his name. What you will need:

Crown template, A4 Card, Colouring Pencils and Pens, String, Scissors ,

Decorations e.g. stickers, feathers.

1. Cut out the crown template
2. Draw around the template on your cardboard
3. Cut out your crown
4. Decorate your crown
5. Put a hole in each side in the middle, see the template
6. Cut 2 pieces of string that will reach from the front to the back of your head
7. Thread a piece of string through each hole and tie a knot so the string won't go through



8. Put on your crown and tie the string at the back

9. Wear your crown!
